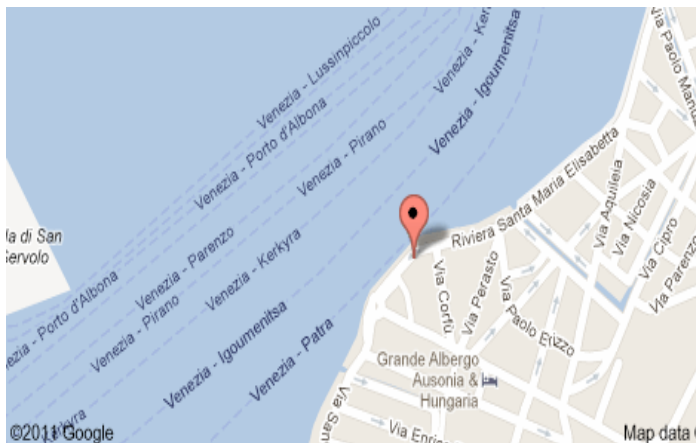
INFORMATION PACK

ACCOMODATION

A room for each participant has been pre-booked by Cities on Water at **Hotel Panorama** for 3 nights (arrival 11th- departure 14 of January). Please mention 'Città d'Acqua' reservation when you confirm. **Each partner will pay the room with his Grundtvig budget** at the departure.

Hotel Panorama is located in a central position on the Lido di Venezia Island, with a breathtaking view over the San Marco bay and the Venetian Lagoon. It occupies an historical early 18th century building, completely renovated in 2000. The exceptional location, only a few step from the ferry terminal, makes the Hotel Panorama the ideal base for discovering the Laguna and its enchanting islands.

The Lido di Venezia offers attractions to guests returning from cultural tours in the city, from golf clubs to tennis courts, horse riding, bicycle tours and exciting helicopter tours of the Laguna.

FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE HOTEL

For Hotel Panorama - Lido

By water

From Marco Polo Airport it is possible to arrive at "Lido-Santa Maria Elisabetta" stop by choosing the **Alilaguna** boat service (www.alilaguna.it);

The Shuttle bus Alilaguna blue line (lineablu) takes you from the Airport to Lido: cost of the ticket **one way 15 € - round trip 25 €** (online 13 € and 24 €).

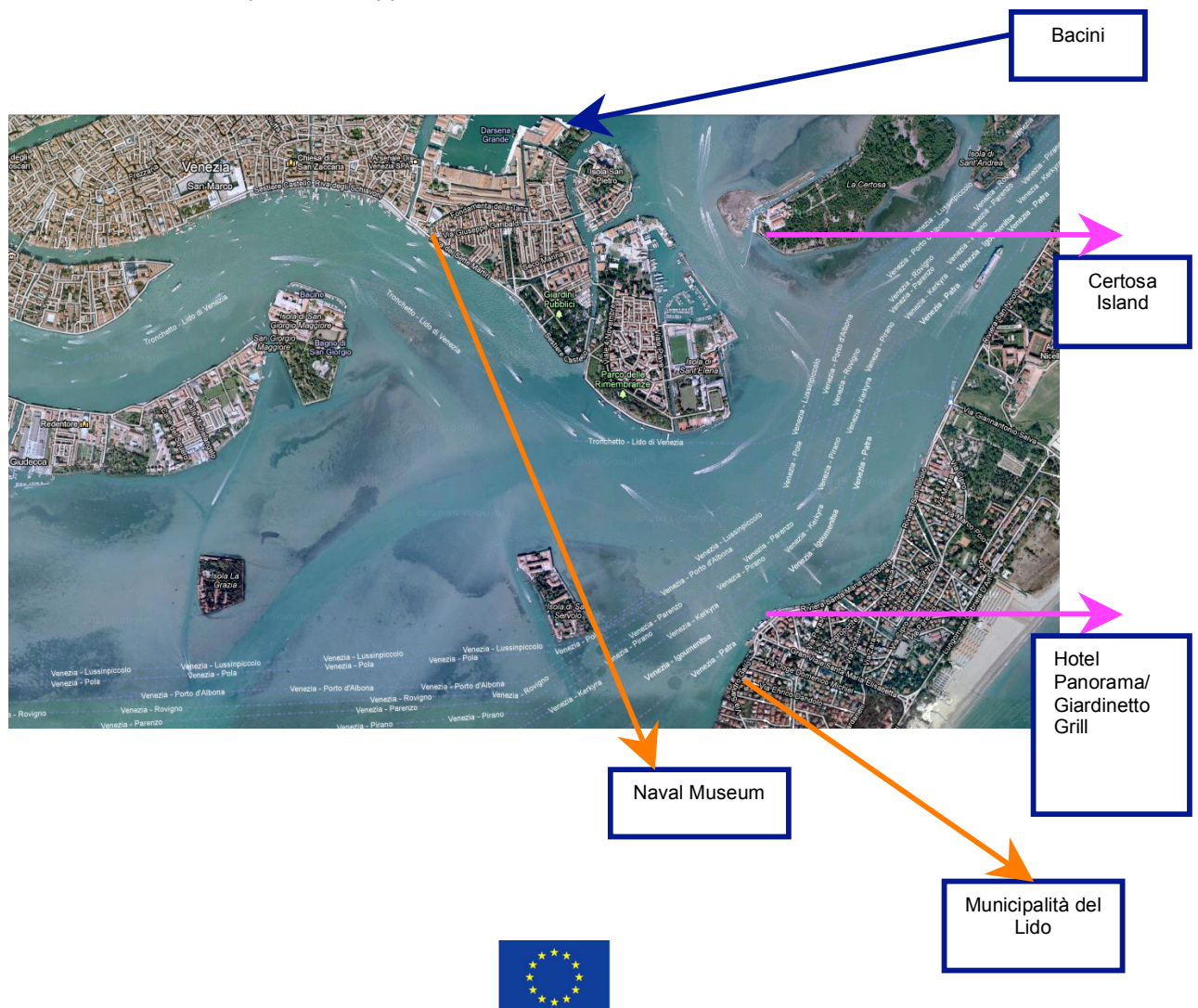
Outside the airport please take the shuttle bus to the water Alilaguna stop and take the **Blue line to Lido**. From the Airport to Lido there is one boat per hour at minutes '15 and '45. The stops are: Airport, Murano Colonna, Fondamente Nuove, Ospedale, Bacini, **Lido Santa Maria Elisabetta**, and the journey will take about 1 hour. There is also **Alilaguna Red Line** leaving from the Airport every hours at minutes '22 (but only from 08,22 to 18,22). Please consult the schedule pdf attached or the [Alilaguna](#) web site for the timetable.

From "Santa Maria Elisabetta" stop, just cross the street in front of you, and you will find the Hotel entrance on your left side.

It is also possible to reach Lido di Venezia **by car** using the **Ferry Boat Line 17** (<http://www.actv.it/en/>) from the mainland (Tronchetto island). Then, once arrived in Lido, follow the waterfront on the right hand side facing the lagoon and you will reach Hotel Panorama. By request, the hotel can provide a certain number of free supervised parking spaces.

You can also reach Venice from the Airport by bus (ACTV line orange) from **Piazzale Roma** (car terminal) and then take the vaporetto to Lido as follows:

- **Number 5.1 or 6.1** along external Canals (faster). Lido is the last stop. It takes approx. 40 minutes.
- **Number 1 or N** at night (direction Lido) that is a more tourist way along the Grand Canal. Lido is the last stop. It takes approx. 1 hours.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Tickets can be bought at waterbus stops, at the self-service ticket machines, as well as from the network of official dealers Actv (tobacconists' and some newspaper shops and kiosks). For online purchases at reduced fares, please visit www.veniceconnected.com.

Single tickets and Travel Cards

- The ordinary waterbus ticket fare is € **6.50**. The ticket is valid for 60' minutes from stamping on the Venice network, excluding Alilaguna. Single tickets can also be bought on board. In this case, however, you must be careful to request the ticket from the attendant as soon as you board.
- **12-hours** Travelcard - € **16,00**, valid from the time of stamping.
- **24-hours** Travelcard - € **18,00**, valid from the time of stamping.
- **36-hours** Travelcard - € **23,00**, valid from the time of stamping.
- **48-hours** Travelcard - € **28,00**, valid from the time of stamping.

VERY IMPORTANT

1. In order to account your travel expenses (**and thus to be refunded by the Grundtvig project**), please remember to keep the **boarding passes of your ticket**. Together with a participation certificate that we will be delivered to you in Venice, the boarding passes would be the proof of your mobility.
